## COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A stamped addressed envelope and the correct entry fee must accompany the entry form otherwise entries may not necessarily be considered .
2. Entries will be dealt with on a first come first served basis and tee times will be notified promptly.
3. Competitors must be bona fide members of a recognized golf club and hold a current handicap certificate which should be available for presentation on the day.
4. Handicap Limits :- Ladies 36 – Gentlemen 28, full handicap allowance. Ladies take strokes and pars from the Ladies card.
5. Competitors must be aged 18 or over on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010
6. In the event of a tie (or ties) the rules of the Cheshire Union of Golf Clubs shall apply and the decision of the management committee in the event of any dispute shall be final.

### Dress Code

1. Smart casual wear is permitted in all rooms. Gentlemen may NOT wear shorts in the upstairs rooms after 7:00pm
2. Full catering facilities are available throughout the day.
3. Prize presentations will take place as soon as possible after the last card has been returned and checked.
4. Winners will be expected to attend the presentation and are asked to wear a jacket and tie.
